READ CAREFULLY!!! I declare to be aware that:

Natural areas present risks such as "floods", thermal shock, drowning, slippery stones, venomous animals, among others, with the visitor being the only responsible for their own safety.

- a) The Crossing Trail Petrópolis-Teresópolis passes through second-degree difficulty sectors of rock climb, with **POTENTIAL RISK OF DEATH**, where it is necessary to use ropes and climb gear. Two sectors require knowledge and habituality with climbing: **CAVALINHO and ELEVADOR**. Bring with you rope and safety gear and make sure you know how to use them.
- b) Electromagnetic storms are frequent in the summer, and there have been cases of death. Try to start the activity as early as possible to minimize this risk.
- c) The temperature can reach 0 ° C very quickly, just as rainfall occurs suddenly. Always wear warm clothing and raincoats.
- d) Although the trail is signaled, there have been incidents where visitors get lost, mainly after the occurrence of fog. It is essential to carry flashlight and reserve batteries. The cell phone flashlight is not enough for your safety.
- e) Always do your poop in the shelters bathrooms. In case of an emergency, make your needs as far as you can from the water streams and always in regions lower than the areas of springs and bury the poop at least 15 cm deep.
- f) Bring along any material used for personal hygiene, scented handkerchiefs are not easily decomposed in nature.
- g) The mountains may have artificial climb protections, steel cables and ropes. The ropes are installed by visitors and are not certified equipment. In case of deteriorated equipment, please inform ICMBio by email usopublico.parnaso@icmbio.gov.br for the activation of FEMERJ.
- h) Search and learn about the location and activity you want to do. Prepare yourself properly. If you do not feel safe for self-guidance, check out the list of guides on the PARNASO website.

IT'S FORBIDDEN TO:

- a) Camping outside the bounded areas around Sino Shelter, Açú Shelter, Teresópolis Shelter (Jaguatirica) and Guapimirim Shelters (Araçari and Jacú), except when previously authorized by ICMBio.
- b) Entrance and exit of the National Park using access other than the venue gates;
- c) Presence of domestic animals inside the National Park, because they can cause damage to wildlife;
- d) Shooting, screaming and making noise that could disturb local wildlife;
- e) Make campfires and drop hot balloons;
- f) Throw garbage on the trails and leave garbage in the mountain camps (Sino and Açú). Users should dispense their garbage in the garbage dumps of the Venues or take it with them outside the National Park;
- g) The carrying of firearms, traps, machetes, scythes, and shooters, except when authorized by ICMBio in specific cases.
- h) Collect plants, flowers and seeds;
- i) Carve names, dates or signs on rocks, trees, buildings, sign boards or other property of National Park;
- j) Use shortcuts and / or access restricted areas;
- k) **Hunt, capture, molest or chase wild animals;**
- l) Do not present the ticket or document that authorizes your stay in the National Park when requested by Park employees;
- m) Refusal of personal identification, when requested by National Park staff;
- n) Consumption of alcoholic beverages outside the cafeteria and restaurant areas. National Park employees have the authority to intervene in necessary cases;
- o) Entering National Park carrying glass bottles;
- p) Parking outside the parking areas. It is forbidden to park in the Dam, Teresópolis Headquarters, between Friday and Sunday and on holidays to access the mountain trails.

I further declare to be aware that:

I - I can be held responsible for the actions practiced by my group;

II - my stay beyond the period provided in this Term is conditional on the authorization and availability of the corresponding vacancies and that I must pay the difference when leaving;

III - I must sign this Term upon leaving the National Park.

FAILURE TO OBSERVE THE ABOVE DETERMINATIONS SHALL DETERMINE THE INFRATOR OF THE PENALTY OF FINE IN THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF R\$ 500,00, ART.90 DECRETO 6.514, DE 22 DE JULHO DE 2008.
